She has taught Literature, Linguistics, English Language Teaching, and Energy and Sustainability Policy (ESP) for over two decades. Her research interests include ESP, syllabus design, materials development, technology-integrated teaching, equity in education, and teacher education. She has published widely in books, renowned national, and international journals.
